

Our commitment to a clean and tidy Djurgarden

Royal Djurgården is an important part of the world's first Royal National City Park. It is a unique area that has been in the hearts of Stockholmers and visitors alike for hundreds of years. Djurgården is surrounded by the delicate and polluted Baltic Sea.

The Baltic Sea, its beaches and our nature are covered in rubbish. And a lot of the rubbish is plastic, which may never fully disappear. One of the biggest causes of this pollution is our behaviour; we eat and drink on-the-go, but we don't take responsibility for where our rubbish ends up.

The Royal Djurgården Society brings together over 50 different organisations who work for the long-term sustainable development of Djurgården. Together we challenge ourselves to come up with innovative solutions. A large number of visitors come to Djurgården every year, which is why it is our responsibility to protect the area and keep it litter-free. Littering is not acceptable, and we strive to reduce our use of single-use plastics in particular. Together we can work for a clean and tidy Djurgården.

Our hope is that, through different initiatives and actions, we can make the difference needed for Djurgården and the Baltic Sea. We also want to inspire others to make positive changes; the starting point is knowing that what we do matters.

Starting spring 2019, we are taking it upon ourselves to work actively to:

- Reduce our use of plastic and replace disposable items with reusable ones in our own operations
- Take action against littering
- Work together to come up with innovate solutions and encourage innovation
- Increase our use of sustainable packaging
- Inspire people to change their habits and actions
